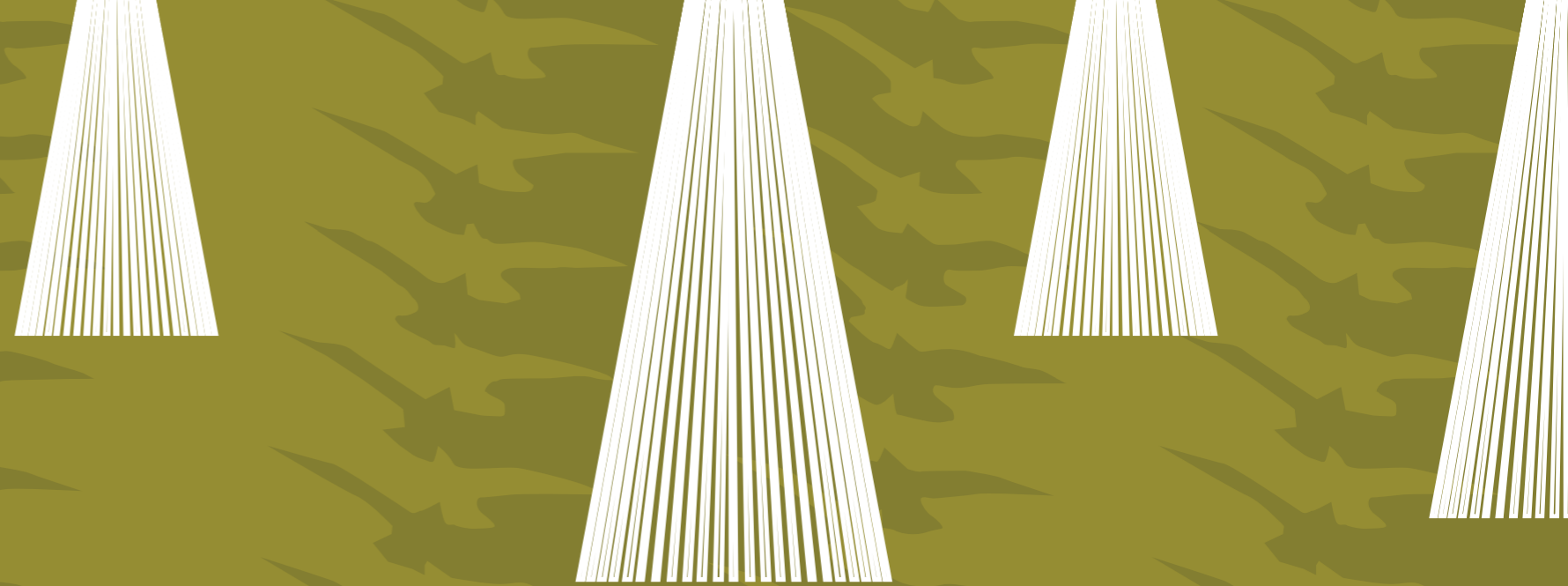

WHITE WINES

San Antonio Pinot Grigio 2006/07, Italy, £13.95
175ml £3.75 | 250ml £4.75
Easy drinking and very capably made. Fresh, dry and delicate with gentle floral and citrus aromas. A classic Italian white wine.

Sauvignon Blanc, Domaine de Montaubéron, 2006, France £13.95
175ml £3.75 | 250ml £4.75
Light grassy, nettle character that is so classic, yet so rare in a Vin de Pays wine. Delicate and aromatic with a bracing, racy streak.

Brown Brothers Chenin Blanc 2005, Australia, £14.95
175ml £4.20 | 250ml £5.20
Intense citrus aromas lead into a palate of fine detailed flavours, richness, viscosity and pace. Here is Chenin Blanc as it should be, but rarely is, from the New World. (4) 12.5%vol

Marques de Caceres Rioja 2006, Spain, £14.95
175ml £4.25 | 250ml £5.25
Buttery short-crust smooth wine. Dry and rounded, but not oaky. Good white Rioja with individual character and texture in a class of its own. (2) 12.5%vol

Benchmark Chardonnay, Grant Burge 2006, South Australia, £14.95
175ml £4.25 | 250ml £5.25
Clean, pure fruit style with tropical fruit and not a jot of oak to interfere - just bright, fresh chardonnay in all its glory. Another classic from this iconic winemaker. (2) 13.5%vol

Viña Carmen Gewurztraminer, 2006, Chile, £14.95
175ml £4.25 | 250ml £5.25
Innocent pale gold colour gives no warning of the splendid high-flying aromatics to follow. Flavours on the palate are both splendid and charming, with notes of roses and lychees. (3) 13.5%vol

Mount Riley Sauvignon Blanc 2007, New Zealand, £21.95
175ml £5.50 | 250ml £6.95
This fruit-driven wine, typical of the highly-acclaimed Marlborough region, has the passionfruit and gooseberry flavours and a neat dash of honeysuckle. (1) 13%vol

Petit Chablis 2005, Domaine Laroche, France, £24.95
Pale lemon-green, full rounded aroma and flavour making a good finish. Very good quality for this appellation. (2) 12.5%vol

Sancerre 2005, Domaine Vacheron, France, £30.00
Highly-praised Sancerre producer living up to the Domaine reputation with a confident and expressive wine. Racy top notes of greengages and fresh-cut grassmeat on a mineral edge. (1) 13%

ROSE WINES

Nuviana Rosado 2006 Valle del Cinca, Spain, £13.95
175ml £3.75 | 250ml £4.75
Bright and invigorating and full of the freshest and most vibrant fruit available. An almost dry style with compact flavours and a good backbone. (2) 12.5%vol

Rosé de la Chevalière, Laroche 2006, France, £15.50
175ml £3.95 | 250ml £4.50
Among the bigger, dryer, richer styles of rosé wines, with bags of forward raspberry fruit and a real noseful of fresh-picked berries. Big enough to match food well, it is no shrinking violet. (2) 12%vol

RED WINES

Nuviana Tempranillo-Cabernet 2005, Valle del Cinca, Spain, £13.95
175ml £3.75 | 250ml £4.75
A wine which is single-handedly shining a light on its quiet corner of Aragon. It has an "ooh" factor of soft ripe fruit at the very first sniff and holds a fresh lean long line of flavour perfectly. (C) 12.5%vol

Hawkes Peak Reserve Red NV, California, £13.95
175ml £3.75 | 250ml £4.75
Fruity, warming and easy-drinking red. (B) 12.5%vol

Terra Andina Cabernet Sauvignon 2005, Chile, £14.95
175ml £3.95 | 250ml £4.95
Intense blackcurrant and dried fruit flavours with a hint of mint, toasted almond, tea, tobacco and cedar oak flavours are melded together with a soft backbone and long finish. (C) 13.5%vol

Benchmark Shiraz, Grant Burge 2005, South Australia, £14.95
175ml £4.25 | 250ml £5.25
Rich aromas of pepper, dark berries and spice. On the palate there are layers of oak, fruit and savoury spice with a smooth finish as long as a tiger's tail. (D) 14.5%

Viña Carmen Pinot Noir, 2005, Chile, £21.00
175ml £4.75 | 250ml £5.75
Bright, light, redcurrant and strawberry fruit Pinot. Classic varietal characteristics with a soft a gentle carapace. Pure refreshment. (B) 14%vol

Rolling Shiraz, Philip Shaw 2004, Australia, £21.95
175ml £5.50 | 250ml £6.95
A wine of fine cool elegance, drawn from its high altitude vineyard and Philip Shaw's famed winemaking skills. Rolling makes its debut to deafening applause. (D) 13.5%vol

Fleurie Belle Grâce 2005, Aujoux, France, £21.95
175ml £5.50 | 250ml £6.95
Absolutely classic raspberries and cream nose that is vibrantly attractive. Soft texture and enticing berry fruit are given a little weight of concentration to make it a serious contender. (C) 13%vol

Marques de Murrieta Rioja Reserva 2001, Spain, £30.00
One of the grandest Riojas - all super-sweet and oaky. The big style emphasizes the intense ripe berry fruit and the busty oak offers overtones of toffee, coffee and coconut. (C) 14%vol

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

Joseph Perrier Cuvee Royal Brut NV, £35.00
One of the great overachieving, underestimated small Champagne houses. It has a relaxed, easy-drinking style with a warm brioche weight to support fresh apple fruit. (1) 12%vol
